### From Central London

- Follow the signs for the M1 & the North.
- Join the M1 and continue northwards, exiting the motorway at junction 10 (signposted Luton South & Airport, A1081).
- Continue on the spur to junction 10a, taking the second exit at the roundabout to join the A1081 (Airport Way), (see inset).
- Take the first slip road off on the left, and then the third exit at the roundabout.
- Continue to the next roundabout and take the third exit, coming back on yourself.
- NorthgateArinso is situated on the left hand side.

### From M25 (Junction 21)

- Exit the M25 at junction 21 (signposted The North, Luton & Airport, M1).
- Continue heading northwards on the M1 for approximately 10 miles, exiting at junction 10 (signposted Luton South & Airport, A1081).
- Continue on the spur to junction 10a, taking the second exit at the roundabout to join the A1081 (Airport Way), (see inset).
- Take the first slip road off on the left, and then the third exit at the roundabout.
- Continue to the next roundabout and take the third exit, coming back on yourself.
- NorthgateArinso is situated on the left hand side.

### From The North (M1)

- Follow the M1 in the direction of London and exit the motorway at junction 10 (signposted Luton South & Airport, A1081).
- Continue on the spur to junction 10a, taking the second exit at the roundabout to join the A1081 (Airport Way), (see inset).
- Take the first slip road off on the left, and then the third exit at the roundabout.
- Continue to the next roundabout and take the third exit, coming back on yourself.
- NorthgateArinso is situated on the left hand side.

### By Train

- The nearest mainline station is Luton Airport Parkway.
